Why Recite It Every Night?



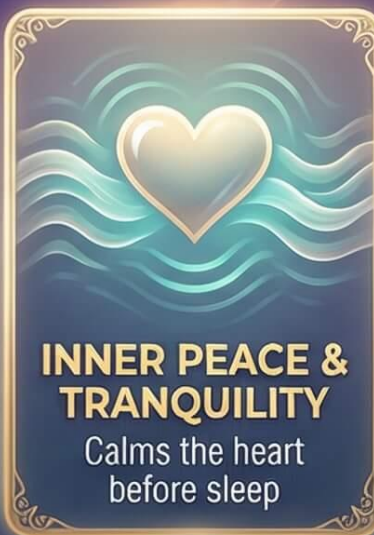
## PROTECTION FROM GRAVE PUNISHMENT

# WHY RECITE BEFORE SLEEP?



## The Nighttime Sunnah



### Grave Protection Activated

The nighttime recitation specifically provides grave protection



### Better Tomorrow

Peace carries over to the next day



### Only 5-7 Minutes

Small investment, massive returns



### Peaceful Sleep

Mind calms down, worries fade away



### End Day with Allah

Fall asleep with remembrance of your Lord

The Companions called it **Al-Mani'ah** during the Prophet's ﷺ lifetime

A practice from 1400+ years ago, still perfect today

**Tonight, before your phone — recite Surah Mulk**

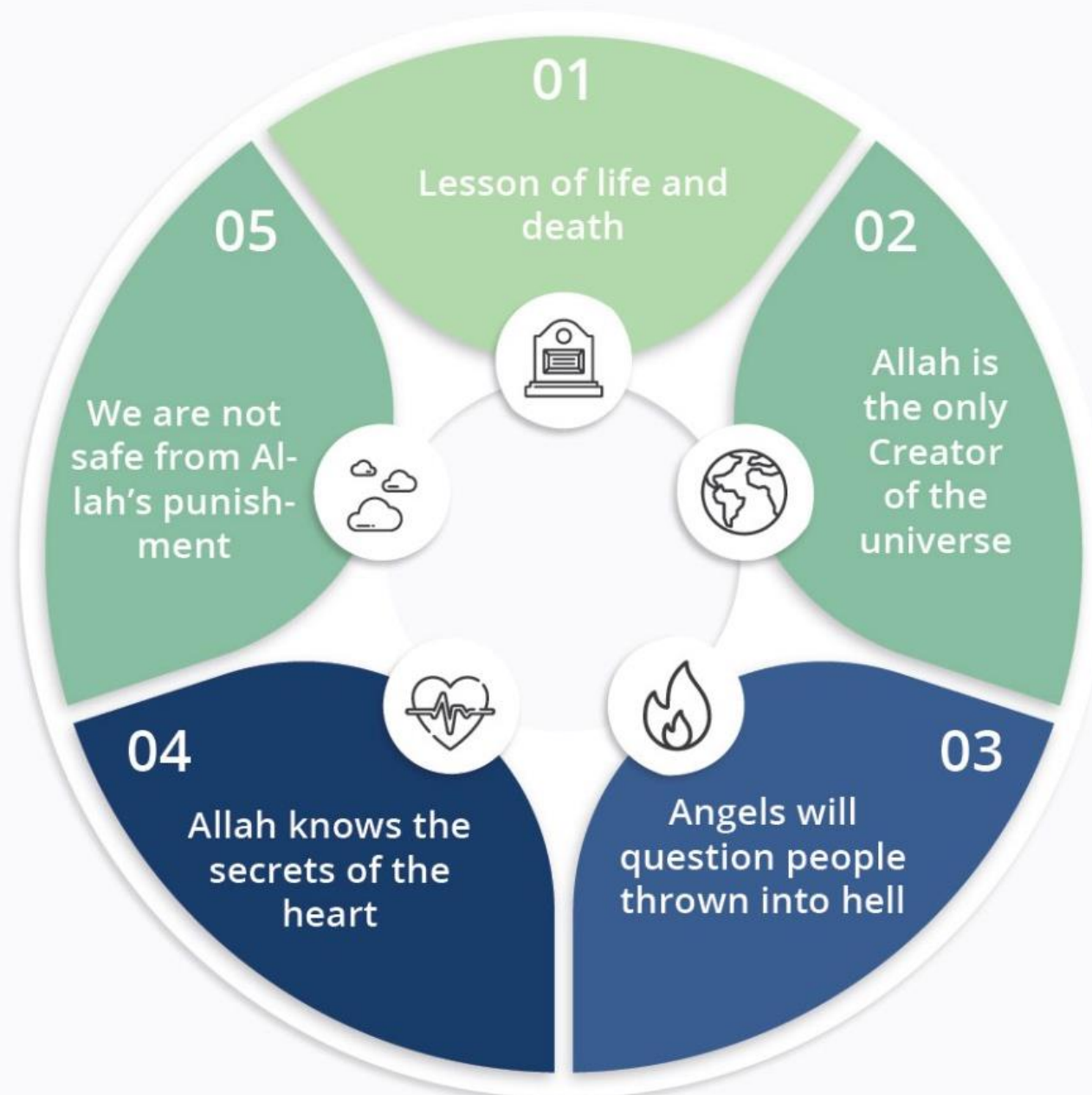

# Virtues of Surah al-Mulk

- 1 The Messenger of Allah ﷺ would not sleep until he had recited Sūrah al-Sajdah and Sūrah al-Mulk. (Tirmidhī)
- 2 The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: “A Sūrah from the Qur’ān containing 30 verses will intercede for a man until he is forgiven. It is Sūrah al-Mulk.” (Tirmidhī)
- 3 ‘Abdullah b. Mas‘ūd ؓ narrated that whoever recites Sūrah al-Mulk every night, Allah will **protect him from the punishment of the grave**. He said: “At the time of the Messenger of Allah ﷺ, we used to call it ‘*al-māni’ah*’ [the protector]. Indeed there is a Sūrah in the Book of Allah [i.e. this Sūrah]; whoever recites it every night has done very well.” (Nasā’ī in ‘Amal al-Yawm wal-Laylah)

## Lessons And Explanations From Sūrat Al-Mulk







فَمَنْ يُجِيرُ الْكَافِرِينَ مِنْ عَذَابٍ أَلِيمٍ

**Who Can Save The Disbelievers From A Painful Torment?"**



- The placement of "Ar-Rahman" in a Surah about "Al-Mulk" is one of the most comforting theological statements in the Qur'an.
- It teaches us that God's default relationship with His creation is one of mercy. **His power serves His mercy.**
- This balance **protects the believer from two extremes**: becoming so comfortable with God's mercy that they forget His power, or becoming so terrified of His power that they despair of His mercy.
- Takeaway: Look for the "Rahmah " within the "Mulk ".

In every sign of God's power you see—a thunderstorm, the vast ocean, the sun—consciously remind yourself of the name "Ar-Rahman".

Say, "The One with the power to do this is also The Most Merciful."

**This practice will cultivate an awe that is rooted in love, not just fear.**

## MOST REPEATED NAMES OF ALLAH IN SURAH AL MULK

### AR RAHMAN

The **Most Merciful** is mentioned **four** times. The dominion of Allah is filled with mercy.

### AR RABB

The **Nurturer** is mentioned **twice**. This means in the dominion of Allah there is **nurturing** out of His vast mercy.

### ALLAH

is mentioned **three** times.

The Main Names of Allah are Allah – Ar Rabb – Ar Rahman are mentioned, yet Ar Rahman is mentioned the most. Thus we should have more **hope** in Allah yet at the same time we should not interfere in the Dominion of Allah.

## REFLECTION

Surah Al Mulk teaches us to **never despair, never give up or lose hope** and rely on the vast mercy of Allah because He will protect us from all evil.

# BUILD YOUR **SURAH MULK** HABIT

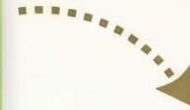
## 4 Steps to Daily Recitation



### Begin by Listening

Find a beautiful recitation online ☐

Even listening brings blessings



### One Verse Per Day

Memorize the Surah in one month ☐

30 verses ÷ 30 days = manageable



### Read the Translation

Know what you're reciting ☐

Understanding deepens connection



### Phone Reminder Before Bed

Until it becomes second nature ☐

After a few weeks, you won't need it



### BONUS TIP

**Parents: Recite with your children!**

Build the habit as a family

**Small steps → Big habits → Eternal rewards**



# SURAH ? MULK FAQ

## Quick Answers to Common Questions

Does it HAVE to be at night?



Night is most emphasized in hadiths, especially before sleep. But reciting anytime still brings blessings.



What if I can't read Arabic?



Start by listening! Work on understanding the translation. Gradually learn the Arabic. Allah rewards effort.



Can children recite it?



Absolutely! Starting young builds lifelong habits. Parents can recite with children at bedtime.



How long does it take?



Only 5-7 minutes once you're familiar with it. Even less time than scrolling social media!



Is once enough or must it be every night?



The greatest benefits come from consistent nightly recitation. Once is good; every night is better.



Have more questions? The best answer is to start tonight!
