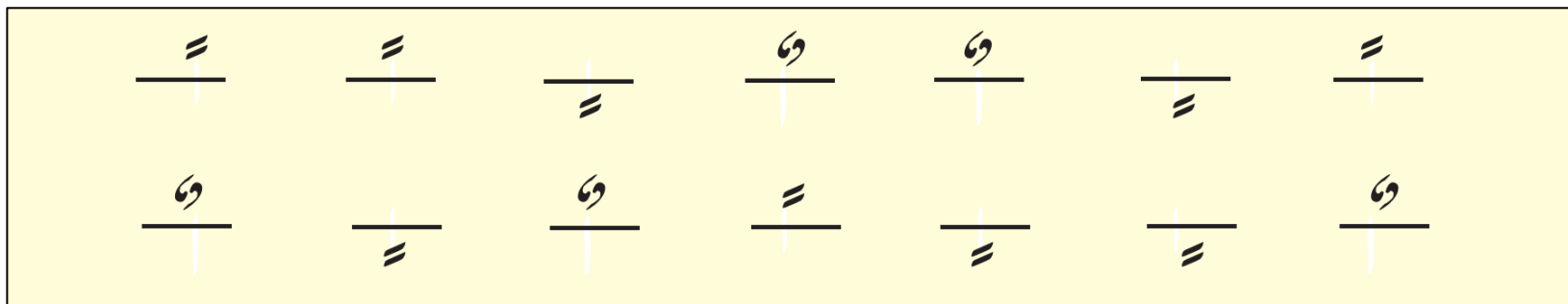

# Introducing Double Strokes (Tanween)



Given below are three kinds of double strokes:

Double *Fathah*  $\text{=}$  double *Kasrah*  $\text{=}$  and double *Dammah*  $\text{=}$ .

The pupil is asked to identify these signs in the following:

A common name for the three signs  $\text{=}$ ,  $\text{=}$ , and  $\text{=}$  is, *Tanween*. If any of these *Tanween* signs is placed upon a letter, it has the effect of producing the sound of ن (with *Jazm*).

Example:- د is the equivalent of دَنْ (dan), دُ is the equivalent of دُنْ (dun), دِ is the equivalent of دِنْ (din) producing the phonetic sounds as in lesson 9.
