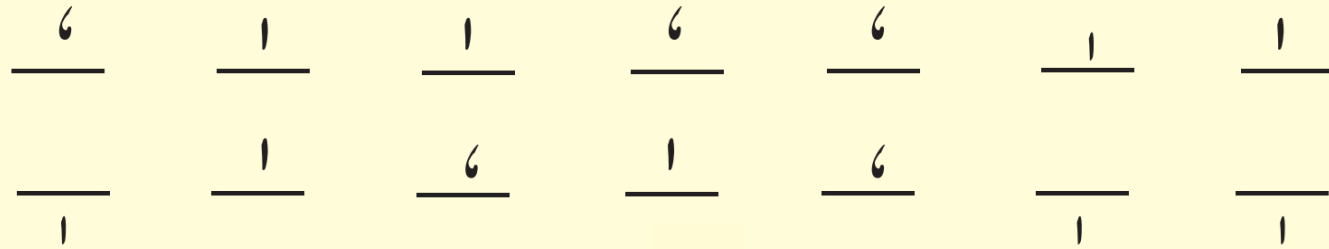


Introducing Vertical and Inverse Strokes

There are three strokes of this kind:

Vertical *Fathah* $\overset{1}{\text{—}}$. Vertical *Kasrah* $\text{—}\underset{1}{}$ and inverse *Dammah* $\overset{6}{\text{—}}$.

The pupil learns to identify them in the following:

Vertical Fathah in Action

Vertical *Fathah* ^ا is the equivalent of *Fathah* and the blank *Alif*.

Example:- تَا is same as تَ *taa* يَا is same as يَ *yaa* is sufficiently high.

تَا تَ مَ ذَ وَا عَ هَ قَ نَ صَ اَ
دَا عَا رَا خَا كَا يَا غَا طَا اَ عَا
