# Reading Practice: Silent Bend

*Shaddah* ّ in effect, is a repetition of a letter, but with two different sounds.

Example:- أَبّ is أَبَب (abba), not (ab-ba). حِلّ is حِلِل (hilli),  
أَفّ is أَفُف (affu).

The whole of it is read in one continuity, with stress on *Shaddah*.
